- **“Where Will the Journey Go?” Book Fair** (January? Publish books right before spring break?)
 - Each class writes a book by having one student write a line, then another student reads what was written before and writes the next line. Where will the journey go?
 - FOS will virtually publish books for STEM community to read.

- **Film Festival**
 - Idea: Do this as a recurring feature with different topics.
 1. First one: Theme = Hope in the New Year
 - a. Organize + promote 5 days of zoom activities for Holiday Break (Dec 28-Jan 1).
 - i. 1 hour zoom call at 10am each of those days
 - ii. Introduce art project for kids to start working on during call.
 - iii. The art projects are related to the idea of Hope.
 - iv. When the kiddos finish their projects, they forward either a photo of the finished project or a 1 minute video of them with their project explaining how it is related to hope or why hope is important or what they hope for in the new year.
 - v. FOS gathers the content from the kids and puts it together in a short film of some sort that we can then distribute for viewing. If there are older (middle school) kids who would like to put the short film together, that would be even better. □ Options for additional films could be:
 1. For MLK Jr day: Social Justice
 - a. FOS can pose a list of questions for kids to respond to, video recorded from home (20 seconds per question max). Those 20 second videos would then be compiled by someone (as class projects maybe or by volunteer adults). Some questions could be:
 - i. What does "Black Lives Matter" mean to you? What have you learned from it?
 - ii. What would you like people to learn from it?
 - iii. Why do you think there is so much violence in Chicago?
 - iv. What do you think MLK Jr would say about civil rights today?
 - v. What do you think about the riots and looting that happened in Chicago this summer?
 - vi. What would you say to people who participated in them?
 - vii. What makes a good leader?
 - viii. Is there a leader that you look up to and admire? Why?
 2. For spring break: Talent Show
 - a. Kids can write + make short films.
 - b. Kids can submit “talent show” type performance.
